VIII International PUNO April Conference in London

“Polish architects in UK and their input into British architecture and town planning since 1945”

The aims of the conference include raising awareness among different communities in Britain of the work and influence of Polish-origin architects on British architecture and town planning, and shedding light on how they developed their careers and architectural vision in Britain. At the conference, papers dealing with the following themes, among others, will be presented.

1. The rebuilding of British cities and towns after the Second World War.
2. The formation and achievements of British-Polish architectural firms active in Britain.
3. Polish-origin architects and town planners settled in England, and Polish newcomers arriving from Poland in recent years - new architectural ideas, completed projects, building and construction in the 21st century.

The conference will be conducted in Polish and English. The conference proceedings will be published in both languages.
